Round table in ONMA: "Maritime claims for ship arrest in Ukraine and responsibility for wrongful arrest: problems and prospects for improving maritime legislation"

Round table in ONMA: "Maritime claims for ship arrest in Ukraine and responsibility for wrongful arrest: problems and prospects for improving maritime legislation" was held in Odessa National Maritime Academy at the Maritime Law and Management Faculty together with Ukrainian Maritime Bar Association and Ukrainian Maritime Community on 15 October , 2015.

The objective of the event is to discuss the status and problems of legal regulation of maritime claims for ship arrest, as well as possible options to resolve the problems identified at the legislative level.

The following issues were discussed during the round table: Court's jurisdiction of ship arrest according to the maritime claims of economic and general courts, the procedure for court applications of ship arrest in accordance with the maritime requirements of the judicial authorities in Ukraine; duration of the ship arrest in accordance with the maritime requirements and the release from arrest, responsibility for wrongful arrest, ship arrest in accordance with the maritime requirements on inland waterways.

The following specialists from different organizations took part in the event: employees of Maritime Security Service of SE "Administration of Sea Ports of Ukraine" (ASPU), the representatives of State Ecological Inspection of Ukraine, judges of Odessa Economic Court of Appeal and Odessa Primorsky District Court, as well as lawyers and attorneys of law firms such as: Sergeyevs' Law Office, law firm "JURLINE", LLC "Sphere of business security", "Lexcellence", "Interlegal", "Rabomizo", "Black Sea Law Company" and others.)
