Visit of the representatives of Nikola Vaptsarov Naval Academy to NU "OMA"

The representatives of Nikola Vaptsarov Naval Academy of the Republic of Bulgaria visited National University "Odessa Maritime Academy" to provide methodological assistance in the creation of maritime tactical computer simulator "Dangerous Waters" from 3 to 7 October. The foreign delegation consisted of the following representatives: Boris Borisov, the Captain of the 1st Rank, Director of Joint Facilities and Coordination Activities Directorate of NVNA, Borislav Nikolov, the Captain of the 3rd Rank, Expert on Information Technology of NVNA, Nikola Stoyanov, Professor, Expert on Maritime Tactical Computer Simulator Issues "Dangerous Waters" of NVNA.

This simulator allows the cadets to practice skills as a part of the ship combat units. The representatives of the Naval Forces of the Armed Forces of Ukraine, the university board as well as the university staff took part in the presentation. The basic feature of the simulator is that the practical exercises will be held by the governing documents of NATO and in English.

The creation of this simulator is the result of collaboration between Naval Faculty of NU "OMA" and Nikola Vaptsarov Naval Academy, the representatives of which, supported in the development of software and installation of computer maritime tactical simulator "Dangerous Waters" as well as held instructor and methodological training with Faculty tutors. In addition, the representatives of higher educational establishments of two countries discussed the perspective directions of cooperation in the preparation of the future officers of the Navy.
