The 13th International Exhibition on Shipping, Shipbuilding and Ports Development “Odessa 2016”

National University «Odessa Maritime Academy» took part in the 13th International Exhibition on Shipping, Shipbuilding and Ports Development “Odessa 2016” within the framework of the International Black Sea Transport Forum-2016, which was held on the territory of the exhibition complex of Odessa Sea Port on 19 - 21 October, 2016.
